ACT/SAT News

ACT/SAT registration materials are available at the College Center. Both testing organizations are strongly encouraging that all registrations be completed online. Practice booklets, registration handouts and paper registration forms are available in the outer office of the Guidance Office.

ACT: Register by November 4 for the December 10 test date online @ www.actstudent.org

SAT: Register by October 7 for the November 5 test date online @ www.collegeboard.org

ATTENTION JUNIORS: We strongly recommend that you plan to take the SAT and /or ACT with Writing by June 2016. BUT, as part of the District Choice State Testing, you will be required to take the ACT (without writing) on March 15 at school. If you plan to take the ACT yourself before then, we recommend

taking it **WITH** Writing so you have it in case any schools you apply to require it. Also, start looking to see if any schools you have interest in will require the SAT II Subject Test scores so you can plan your testing schedule ahead of time.
